INTRODUCING TRANSPORT 2020 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS FOR THE DANE COUNTY / GREATER MADISON METROPOLITAN AREA

One of the most important travel corridors serving the greater Madison metropolitan region runs through Madison's isthmus. Over the past two decades, this corridor has experienced increasing traffic congestion, safety problems, and pedestrian and bicycle transportation challenges. In addition, other travel corridors throughout the region (connected to the primary isthmus corridor) are also experiencing transportation challenges. The study will investigate options for improving the transportation capacity of these important regional travel corridors.

The study will include a careful examination of a broad range of transportation system alternatives, and a thorough assessment of how these various alternatives address the problems and challenges identified in the study area. The study will also determine what the impacts will be if nothing is done to address these travel challenges.

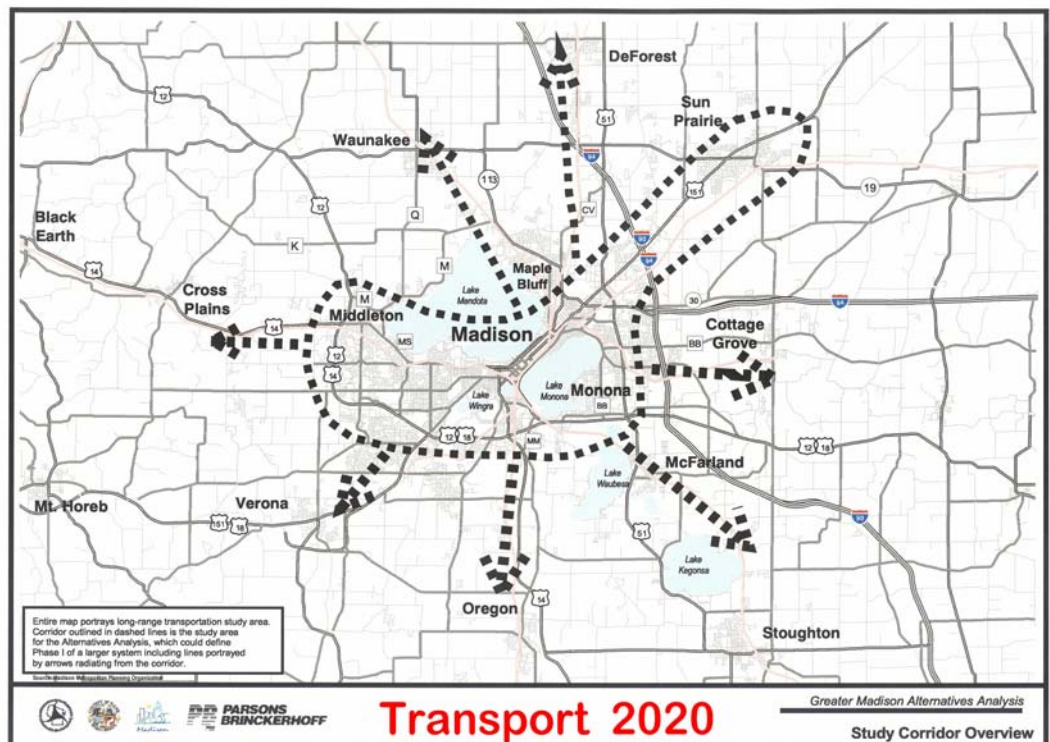
